Description: This scholarship is for any graduating high school senior or undergraduate college student (with priority given to high school students) who is planning to pursue or currently pursuing a major in the arts (e.g., fine arts, graphic arts, performing arts, visual arts).

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Meet the minimum eligibility criteria already delineated on the HTELC scholarship main page (www.holytrinityinglewood.com/wp/scholarships).
- Be planning to pursue or currently pursuing a major in the arts (e.g., fine arts, graphic arts, performing arts, visual arts)
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or above in the most recently completed semester/quarter of coursework
- Demonstrate financial need
- Have completed 15 hours of community service within the last academic year, 6 of which must have been done at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church or another church of choice

Required Submission Materials

To be considered for this scholarship award, you must submit the following:

- ✓ The Online HTELC Scholarship Application with the following attachments:
 - Most recent grade report/transcript
 - Current official written acceptance letter from a college/university
 - HTELC Financial Needs Assessment Form and FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)
 - Community Service Hours Verification form for HTELC Scholarship Applications
- ✓ A 200-500 word essay that: a) is well-written, b) provides clear evidence of a solid vision for pursuing a major and career in the arts (e.g., fine arts, graphic arts, performing arts, visual arts)
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation:
 - One from a teacher/instructor/professor
 - One from your pastor
